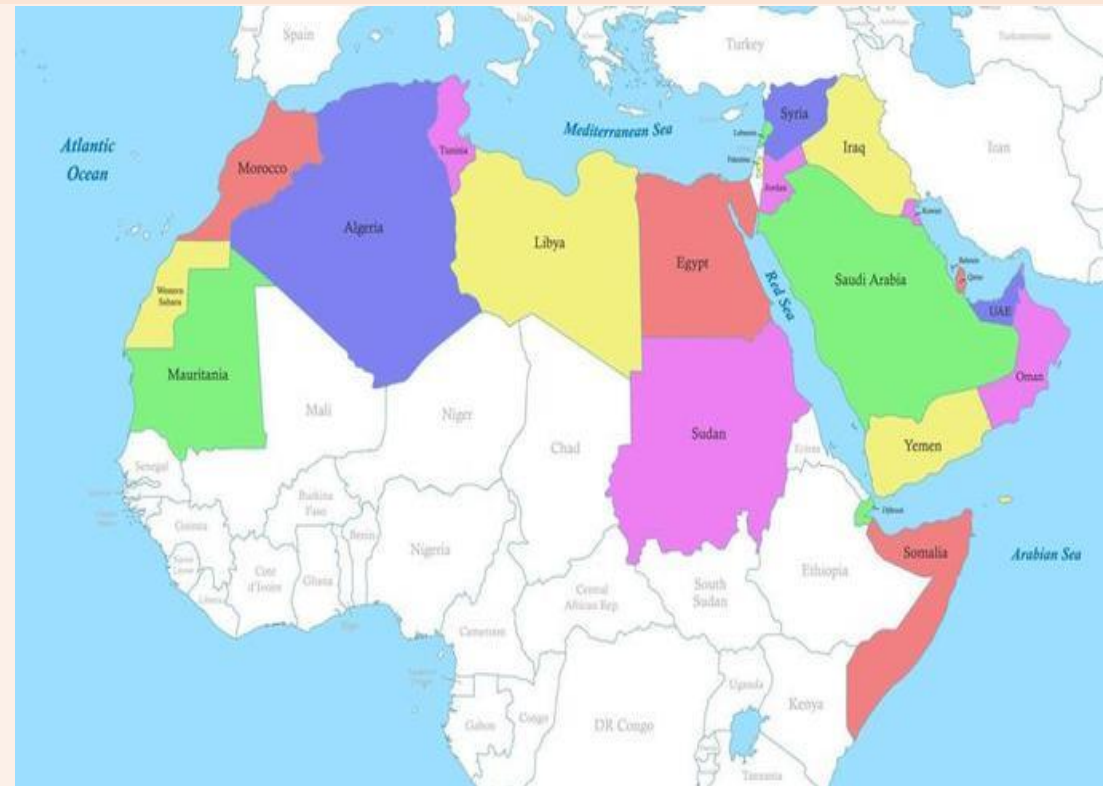

My Role as an Intercultural Worker at the Municipality of Brno

- **Language Support:** Providing translation and interpretation services to bridge language barriers.
- **Cultural Mediation:** Helping individuals from different cultural backgrounds understand each others' customs, norms, and values.
- **Orientation Programs:** Assisting newcomers in adapting to the local culture and community life.
- **Resource Connection:** Linking individuals and families with local services, such as healthcare, education, and housing.

My Role at the Municipality of Brno

- Offering support to individuals and families dealing with the emotional stress of cultural adaptation.
- Guiding and mentoring individuals through their integration process, providing them with the tools and confidence needed to thrive in a new environment
- Organize focus groups with community members to understand their needs and how your services can address them.
- Communicate with other organizations and try to benefit from their services and activities

Promoting my Services

- **Social Media:** I use social media platforms like Facebook, WhatsApp
- **Distribute flyers and brochures** in multiple languages at community centers, libraries, schools, and other public places.



Activities
